

## **\*Board Allows Timber Bid Project To Continue**

IRONWOOD TOWNSHIP – The Ironwood Township Board of Trustees discussed the future of timber sales on township property Monday. Justin Miller, of Green Timber Consulting Foresters, Inc., spoke about putting together bid packages for companies to harvest the western portion of property near Lost Lake. According to Miller, the section of property is adjacent to where a previous harvest took place. Once the section is done, the township could then proceed to harvest the northernmost portion. “The northernmost property would not be ready until 2020,” Miller said. He also discussed the work schedule, and how things like income schedules in the bid packages would affect the number of bidders. The board agreed to allow Miller to continue with the project by creating the bid packages. “You have done a great job, so far, and keep up the good work,” trustee Bernie Brunello said.
